Responsibilities:

- Run our annual Leadership Development Program inclusive of content creation, logistics, and supporting grant development
- Support the running of our Mentorship Program along with the VP of Diversity & Inclusion
- Work collaboratively across the organization to understand the leadership and educational needs
 of both student and professional members
- Define an education strategy with clear outcomes and a plan for accomplishing those outcomes
- Advise the board on best practices in the spaces of leadership and educational development
- Create materials and programs that support the outcomes of an education strategy
- Establish and support a committee of volunteers to accomplish these responsibilities

Expectations:

- Regularly check-in with members of the Leadership & Education committee
- Understand needs of professional and student members and develop professional development resources that support both groups
- Participate in discussions and contribute to key decisions made by the executive committee
- Attend weekly teleconference/videoconference meetings and stay up-to-date with initiatives
- Represent oSTEM with professional behavior consistent with our mission and core values
